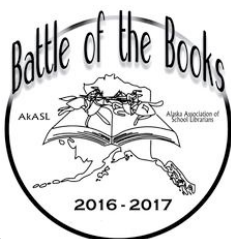
If you can help pack up the Book Fair on October 28th in the afternoon or you can help set up for the carnival please let us know.
